REFINERY INFORMATION

Located on the Cook Inlet, 60 miles southwest of Anchorage, Alaska, the Kenai Refinery can process up to 72,000 barrels per day (bpd). The refinery produces gasoline and gasoline blendstocks, jet fuel, diesel fuel and heavy fuel oils, propane and asphalt. Crude oil is delivered by truck, double-hulled tankers through Cook Inlet and pipeline from the Kenai Peninsula and Cook Inlet.

A 69-mile, 48,000 bpd common-carrier products pipeline transports jet fuel, gasoline and diesel fuel to the Port of Anchorage and the Anchorage International Airport. Wholesale delivery occurs through terminals in Kenai, Anchorage, the Nikiski dock and the Port of Anchorage.

The refinery also supplies Andeavor's network of Tesoro® and USA Gasoline™ stations throughout Alaska.
