While at PwC, he had more than 25 years of experience providing auditing and advisory services to a wide variety of private, public and multinational companies. Mr. Templin joined PwC in Pittsburgh in 1984. While at PwC, he went on to serve in London, Kazakhstan and Baltimore before assuming his position in Atlanta in 2009. He was appointed senior vice president and chief financial officer of Marathon Petroleum in 2011 and took on the incremental role of chief financial officer of MPLX GP LLC in 2012. Mr. Templin was named executive vice president, Supply, Transportation and Marketing of Marathon Petroleum in 2015. He was appointed executive vice president of Marathon Petroleum and president of MPLX GP LLC in 2016 and president of Marathon Petroleum in 2017. He assumed his current position in 2018.

Mr. Templin is a graduate of Grove City College, a certified public accountant and a member of the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. He attended the Oxford Institute for Energy Studies in 2012.

Mr. Templin serves on the board of directors of the general partners of MPLX LP and Andeavor Logistics LP. He previously served on the board of directors of Calgon Carbon Corporation until its sale in March 2018. Mr. Templin is a member of the Grove City College Board of Trustees. He is also a member of the downstream committee of the American Petroleum Institute (API).
