Mr. Wilkins is senior vice president, Health, Environment, Safety and Security of Marathon Petroleum Corporation.

After a short time as a field engineer with Dowell Schlumberger, Mr. Wilkins began his career with Marathon in October 1990 at the Garyville refinery in Louisiana. He held various environmental roles until 1997 when he was promoted to Environmental and Safety manager at Garyville. In 1999, Mr. Wilkins transferred to corporate refining operations supporting the environmental, safety, and security functions within the organization. In 2004, he was promoted to manager, Refining Environmental, Safety and Security. In 2013, Mr. Wilkins assumed responsibility over process safety management (PSM) and promoted to director, Refining Environmental, Safety, Security, and PSM. In 2016, Mr. Wilkins assumed company-wide oversight responsibility and was named director, Environment, Safety, Security, and Product Quality. He was named vice president, Environment, Safety and Security in 2018 and assumed his current position in 2021.
