In 2023, annual dues greater than \$50,000 incurred by Marathon Petroleum Corporation for national trade associations totaled \$21.08 million, of which approximately \$940 thousand (4%) was attributable to federal lobbying efforts and approximately \$6.93 million (33%) was attributable to state and grassroots lobbying and broad advertising communications designed to generally promote the energy industry and educate consumers.

Approximately \$13.22 million (63%) of Marathon Petroleum Corporation payments made to national trade associations in 2023 was attributable to tax-deductible program-related activities such as training and the establishment of industry standards.
