EL PASO REFINERY SUSTAINABILITY HIGHLIGHTS

Our El Paso refinery is located approximately three miles east of downtown El Paso, Texas, and processes both sweet and sour crude oils to meet regional energy demands. Originally two separate facilities, the northern portion built by Chevron in 1928 and the southern portion by Texaco in 1931, the site has been modernized over the years. In 1993, the two plants were fully integrated into a single operation. The refinery operates with a strong commitment to environmental stewardship, community partnership and a culture of safety. Refined products are distributed efficiently through pipelines, trucks and rail.
