Our Garyville refinery, located along the Mississippi River in southeastern Louisiana between New Orleans and Baton Rouge, is configured to process a wide variety of crude oils and plays an essential role in supporting regional energy demands. With multiple options to sell refined products—including access to the export market—the facility operates under a deep commitment to environmental stewardship, community partnership and the promotion of a culture of safety. Products are distributed efficiently through pipelines, barges, transport trucks, rail and ocean tankers.
